Whale & Dolphin Watching





The Azores Archipelago is one of the premier whale and dolphin watching sites in the world, and the subject of films by the BBC and National Geographic.

Join us on one of our exciting whale and dolphin watching holidays. When out at sea the species we most frequently see are sperm and pilot whales, beaked whales and false killer whales, together with bottlenose, common, spotted, Risso's and striped dolphin. In recent years, we have also sighted blue, fin, sei, minke and humpback whales off the islands' shores.

These elusive mammals are spotted by the 'vigia', a lookout on the coast. Using powerful binoculars, he guides our boats from the shore to their location. This traditional system works well and was used for many years when the Azorean people hunted the whales.

Some of our boats also use an onboard hydrophone (underwater microphone) to find the cetaceans, and when at sea, they rarely go more than 10 miles from land. The boat skippers are keen to see the cetaceans and will point them out to you, identify the species and give you time to marvel at the spectacle and grab some fantastic photos too (if you're quick!).

Choose from our whale watching holidays on São Miguel, Faial or Pico. However, if you wish to extend your holiday, stay in different accommodation or combine a whale and dolphin trip with another activity, call us with your requirements and we'll provide a quotation.

Half day whale watching

We offer half day whale and dolphin watching trips on the following islands; São Miguel, Faial, Pico and Terceira. Each trip lasts for approximately 3 hours and includes a safety briefing and introduction to the whale and dolphins you are likely to see. We offer trips in RIBs or larger fibre glass boats. Children under 4 years and pregnant women are not allowed on the RIBs.

Full day whale watching and snorkelling

On São Miguel from June to September it is possible to join one of our whale watching trips for the morning and in the afternoon visit the small collapsed volcano of Ilhéu de Vila Franca off the coast of Vila Franca where you can swim and snorkel in the lagoon. The day also includes pre-trip briefing, snorkels and lunch.

Swimming with dolphins

We offer half day swimming with dolphins on the islands of São Miguel and Faial. If you are new to this experience or have not snorkelled before we also offer a full day introduction to swimming with dolphins. The day starts off with a briefing on how to snorkel; you then have a practice session in a swimming pool. Once you are confident with the equipment you then try snorkelling from the shore. After lunch you head out to sea for an afternoon of swimming with dolphins. The trips include: wet suit, buoyancy aid, snorkel, safety briefing and lunch on the full day trips. For children under 12 it is advisable to bring your own wet suits.

Please note, each trip is limited to 10 swimmers, and at any one time only two people are allowed in the water.

Blessed with a temperate climate due to the warming effect of the gulf stream, the Azores is home to over 25% of the world's whale and dolphin species. Some, including the sperm whale are resident throughout the year while others (e.g. the blue whale) migrate through from March to May on their way north. Vila Franca, the historical capital of São Miguel, with its small harbour and cobbled streets is an ideal base.

During your week away you discover why the Azores is such an important environment for cetaceans, the different types of whales and dolphins found around the islands and the relationship between whales and man and how they have created a unique place in the psyche of the Azorean people.

Our whale watching holiday on Faial is based in the cosmopolitan town of Horta. Four half days are spent whale and dolphin watching, allowing you a further four full days to explore the two beautiful islands of Faial and Pico (and even São Jorge on the ferry from June to September).

Sights to see include Capelinhos, a village that was buried in the 1957/8 eruption that is now

re-appearing out of the ash and Faial's volcanic crater which offers great views of the surrounding area. You can take a 25 minute ferry ride to Pico and visit the whaling museums, cheese and wine factories or even climb the mountain if you're feeling energetic. Perhaps extra whale-watching or relaxing in a café is more your scene. Whatever you choose, a fantastic holiday awaits you.

For something a little different, our unique **Whale & Dolphin Research Holidays** combine a journey of imagination with real exploration of these elusive creatures.

Not only are our Whale & Dolphin Research Holidays a fascinating adventure, but they can make a real difference to the welfare of the Azores cetaceans, as your booking cost directly funds the important research carried out on board during your tour. This is not a working holiday though – the atmosphere on board is very relaxed but learning is on the agenda. You will get first hand knowledge of the whale and dolphins' behaviour, a slide show, plus talks about the creatures and the research.

The trips are guided by the leading Azores cetacean biologist, Lisa Steiner, who has spent the last 19 years researching and studying Azorean Cetaceans, and Lisa will be on board whenever you are at sea. You will watch the whales and dolphins in their

natural environment, find out how individual animals are identified, and see scientific data being collected on the various species.

Your vessel for these trips is *Physeter*, a specially converted motor catamaran that provides

shade from the sun, hot and cold drinks, toilet and full safety equipment. Her 4 tiered decks provide guests with a variety of excellent whale and dolphin watching view points.

Quiet country lanes, lovely accommodation and wholesome meals make for a perfect Azores cycling experience.

Cycling from village to village allows you to thoroughly explore these delightful islands and the itineraries detailed take you to some of the less visited parts of the Azores. Most roads in the Azores are very quiet and often you find yourselves cycling alongside thick hydrangea hedges and hillsides heavy with cryptomeria forests.

We offer three varied itineraries for the cyclist. Distances vary between 15 and 35km per day and accommodation is in comfortable hotels and guest houses. Luggage is transferred between hotels and bikes are modern Specialised hybrids or Trek tourers, with pannier, pump, repair kit and tools. Helmets are not included however we strongly advise bringing your own.

All our independent cycling tours are fully flexible and can be organised in minimum 3 day sections. This way you can combine cycling with other activities or just spend the rest of your holiday relaxing at a hotel of your choice.

São Miguel Trail Walking

Explore the sights and discover the natural beauty of this incredible island at your very own pace.

We have created two independent walking itineraries that will take you through some of the most stunning scenery in the Azores. Choose from either Self-Drive or Taxi-Transfer. Self-Drive includes a hire car and planned circular walk routes providing complete freedom during your stay, while with the Taxi-Transfer option, the walks are mostly linear – a driver will drop you off at the start of each walk and pick you

up later that day. Detailed route maps are provided for both options, leaving you free to explore the sights of São Miguel at your leisure.

You will be staying in two great hotels during your holiday. Firstly, at the Hotel Terra Nostra (page 29), located in the volcanic basin of Furnas, and secondly, in Ponta Delgada at the Hotel do Colegio (page 26).

From the volcanic basin of Furnas you will visit the more remote eastern end of the island, walking through an abandoned village and up to a stunning waterfall, along a pretty south coast path and you'll have time to explore the Terra Nostra botanical gardens in Furnas, taking a dip in the thermal waters. From your Ponta Delgada base, you'll get to see Sete Cidades as well as the Fire Lake. Walks vary from 6km to 12km (2 to 5 hours).

Multi-Island Trail Extensions

We also organise independent trails on São Jorge, Pico, Faial, Santa Maria and Flores. They can be added to the São Miguel Green Isle Trails, or included in any other holiday combination. Suggested itineraries are detailed below (2 walks per extension), but it really is your choice – all can be tailored to suit your requirements.

Azorean Coastal Trails Flores, 4 nights*

The walks on Flores allow you to walk the whole of the spectacular west coast of the island in 2 days passing cascading waterfalls, through abandoned villages and wonderful sub-tropical vegetation. The walks are between 9 and 11km but usually take 3 to 4 hours to complete as you'll be wanting to stop to enjoy the fabulous scenery. On your free day, we suggest a boat trip to nearby Corvo or a jeep tour of Flores.

Here you will have the chance to walk from fajã (coastal plain) to fajã and wind your way between the eerie green craters on the top of the island before descending to a pretty coastal village for a refreshing dip in the ocean. Walks are 9-18km taking between 3.5 and 5 hours. On your free day, why not swim in the natural rock pools in Velas or take a taxi out to see the pretty forest park of Sete Fontes.

You will be based on Faial for your whole stay and walking round part of the wonderful crater rim before visiting the volcanic site of Capelinhos. On another day, you will take the ferry over to Pico (30 mins – not included) for a leisurely downhill walk from the slopes of Mt Pico. Walks vary from 9-10km taking 3 hours. On your free day, we suggest you explore Horta and its beaches or go out whale watching.

The walks on Santa Maria provide a wonderful introduction to this less visited island. Starting off in Santa Barbara your first walk is circular and takes you through pretty villages on the north east side of the island to the small church of Nossa Senhora de Lurdes which has wonderful views across the meadows and down to the ocean. Your second walk starts at the highest point on Santa Maria (Pico Alto, 590m), where on clear days you get wonderful panoramic views across the island and down to São Pedro, the small hamlet where you will be based. Walks are between 10 and 13kms and take bewteen 3 and 5 hours.

Our new fully guided walking tour now includes Terceira

Walking is one of the best ways to get to know the islands, and our guided tour covers no less than five of the Azores' most stunning islands – São Miguel, Terceira, São Jorge, Faial and Pico. During your trip you'll witness secluded lagoons as you stroll from fajã to fajã (coastal plain), view magnificent panoramas from the slopes of the highest mountain in Portugal, sense the tranquility that surrounds the great crater lakes and see the fascinating results of the most recent Azorean eruption.

You'll also have enough free time to enjoy the towns and villages at your own pace, sampling the local delicacies and watching the calm pace of local life go by.

We'll be staying in comfortable hotels throughout the holiday and using taxis to transfer us to and from the walks. Walks are gently paced (we won't be racing to the finish!) and are aimed at the moderately fit. No walk is longer than 18km and most will be around 10km.



São Miguel Volcanic Diving

The largest island of the archipelago, São Miguel offers some unique dives such as the beautiful islet of Vila Franca do Campo; an ancient volcanic crater just 2 miles offshore. There is a lagoon inside which you can enter as part of the crater wall has collapsed due to marine erosion and tectonic movement. The dive is 20m deep with caves and the crater is also a breeding area for the Cory Shearwater. Other sites include the spectacular vertical rock islets off Mosteiros on the west coast and some easy dives accessible by land from the pretty port of Caloura on the south coast.

Santa Maria Oceanic Diving

Here you'll find around 70 recognised dive locations including 15 caves and 12 offshore sites. One of the main highlights is diving with impressive Manta Rays, the largest of all rays. 24 miles offshore lies the Formigas Rocks, a North Atlantic hotspot, and a further 3 miles you'll find Dollabarat, a seamount whose depth rises from several hundred metres up to just 4 metres! Visibility off Santa Maria ranges from 20-40m average to 60m in very good conditions.

Pico Undiscovered Diving

With over 30 sites, Pico is one of the premier diving islands in the Azores. Dives are a mix of shore and boat dives and include the famous Princess Alice Bank (a submerged seamount 50 nautical miles south west of Pico). a lighthouse and reef dive near Lajes, a dive through an impressive arch to a reef on the south east coast and a shore dive which takes you to a 50m drop off and a cavern full of wreck fish. The dive centre we use is a highly professional BSAC Premier School so courses are also available.






JEEP TOURS ISLANDS São Miguel, Faial, Flores







Crossing the 4 mile channel which separates the islands of Faial and Pico, you arrive in Horta, the island's capital and the liveliest and most eye-catching town of the Azores. It is a haven for yachtsmen and whalewatchers, filled with colourful yachts which stop here during their voyage across the North Atlantic. The bustling international atmosphere is characteristic to Horta, where yachtsmen, visitors and locals swap dreams and adventures over a beer or coffee.

Faial was the last location of major volcanic activity in the Azores, when Capelinhos erupted (1957-58), adding 1km² of land to the island. Today, you can visit the site and marvel at the power of the eruption which engulfed a whole village in 5m of volcanic ash. This area, resembling the surface of the moon, is in stark contrast to the hydrangealined lanes of the rest of the island.

A visit to the crater of Monte da Guia above Horta and a climb to the Whaler's Chapel offer a spectacular view of Faial and Pico. Descending from here to the bay of Porto Pim, a sandy beach and safe blue sea awaits you.

The Furna do Enxofre (Sulphur Cavern), is a unique geological phenomenon. In the interior of this former volcano is an extraordinary sight: a tunnel, about 100 metres deep, opens into a huge grotto with a magnificent volcanic vault (80 metres high), and a lake filled with cold sulphurous water. Reached via a 90 metre stone spiral staircase, it is simply awe-inspiring.

The second largest island of the Archipelago, Pico offers a landscape of dramatic contrasts. The Capitão, Caiado, and Paúl lakes are set within rugged moor land along the spine of the island, whilst the mountain climb offers a spectacular view on a clear day of the five islands of the central group. Sunrise viewed from the summit is truly an unforgettable sight.



São Jorge is one of the most scenically dramatic and friendly islands of the group, and is an ideal base from which to explore with regular ferry connections to Pico and Faial. Velas, the picturesque capital, is a sleepy harbour town dating from the mid 1400s and has a delightful, traditional Azorean bandstand in the main square.

The majority of the locals live on the coastal plains (fajãs). These fajãs lie at the foot of the steep volcanic cliffs, and are home to an abundance of bird life including the Cory Shearwater. The Topo islet, at the east end of the island, with its nesting and resting areas for many resident and migratory birds, has been classified a Natural Reserve.

One of the most beautiful walks heads off from the top of the island down to Fajā do Santa Cristo with its pretty church and lagoon. After a refreshing swim in the ocean, you continue along the coastal path past an abandoned fajā until you reach the stunning Fajā dos Cubres.

While you're there make sure you sample the local delicacies of the famous Sao Jorge cheese and the clams farmed in the lagoons on a number of the Fajãs.



CORVO

Flores is an island of incomparable beauty, due to its different geological structure, jagged terrain and beautiful flora. Waterfalls plunge down green cliffs into the ocean, the landscape has deep creases formed by eons of volcanic activity, and tiny whitewashed villages nestle on the coastal plains.

The western-most village in Europe, Fajã Grande, is backed by a natural bowl with myriad cascades, tropical foliage and romantic pools. The little capital of Santa Cruz on the east coast is home to fishermen and boat builders and is a haven for native birds.

One of the main attractions of Flores is its seven extinct craters. Once active volcanoes, they are now beautiful mountain lakes.

To the north of Flores, a 6omin boat trip takes you to the smallest island, Corvo. The picturesque town of Vila Nova with a population of just 400 is a maze of narrow streets, called 'canadas', waiting to be explored. Monte Grosso, the highest point on the island offers an extraordinary view overlooking the steep sided crater that formed the island.



Cuada

Abandoned village brought to life!

On the west coast of the island, lies the lovely village of Cuada. - 3) the tailormade itinerary4) the Operator's current "Dates and Prices" all of which are hereby incorporated into and shall constitute the entire contract made between the Operator and the Client. The Client agrees that the pre departure information booklet sent to him after booking does not in any way constitute part of the

The Price The price of the Tour as set out in the Operator's brochure (Prices From) are current at the time of booking or specified on the clients quotation, if the Tour booked is part of the Tailormade programme.

Date of Departure The date of commencement of the Tour as set out in the quotation agreed with the client.

Force Majeure Unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond the control of the Operator, the consequences of which could not have been avoided, even if all due care had been exercised which without prejudice to the generality of the above shall include war, threat of war, riot, civil disobedience or strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity, natural or nuclear disaster, fire or adverse weather conditions, technical or maintenance problems with transport and changes of schedules or operational decisions of air carriers.

A) BOOKING CONDITIONS

1) Brochure/website Description

The contents of the brochure/website are based on knowledge and information available to the Operator prior to publication of the brochure/ website and several months prior to the date of departure. No changes will be made to the particulars contained in the brochure/website relating to the Tour unless they are also clearly communicated to the Client before the Contract is made with the Client or, if the changes are made after the Contract is made, only with the agreement of the Client.

2) Deposit

A deposit of £125 per person shall be sent by the Client to the Operator with the completed Booking Form. The Client understands that any special medical conditions, dietary requirements or needs must be made known to the Operator when booking. 3) Acceptance of Deposit

4) Balance of Payment

7.4.1 The Operator will endeavour, at all times after a booking is taken, to provide the tour booked by the Client. However, the Operator reserves the right to cancel a tour up to 70 days before its scheduled Date of Departure. In such circumstances the Client will be entitled to-

- b) If this is not available or acceptable by the Client, a refund of all monies paid.

Accommodation

You will find that most hotels and guest houses in the Azores have twin rooms rather than rooms with a double bed. Sometimes it is possible to book a double room, so please let us know if you would specifically like this.

The accommodation we have selected covers a wide range of tastes and includes many 'Quintas'. A Quinta is a farmhouse or manor house and these have generally been carefully restored with the help of government grants in an effort to encourage this type of traditional but excellent quality tourism. As these are houses and not purpose-built hotels, not all rooms are identical and they are generally missing many of the facilities you would usually find in a hotel, although you can be assured of a friendly welcome and a more relaxed atmosphere.

*Photographs of hotel rooms in the brochure reflect a variety of room types and in some cases may be superior rooms or suites. It is important to specify your preferred room type when booking.

Azorean food and language

There are many pleasant cafés and restaurants (many of which we list in the pre-departure information we send you) on all the islands and prices are reasonable. For dinner (with wine) allow £10-£15 per person, although it can be done more economically.

Local beef, pork and chicken are readily available and few dishes are highly spiced. Local fish is a speciality and greatly varied. Azorean bread and cheese are excellent and easy to find. Salads are fairly readily available although often are quite basic and vegetarian dishes are slowly starting to appear on menus. There are small supermarkets in most towns and like all shopping, prices are displayed and fixed.

If you do not speak Portuguese, you should not worry about getting by in the Azores. Many Azoreans have lived abroad for part of their lives and the young people often speak excellent English. Learning a few Portuguese phrases is always appreciated however, and you can make friends quickly if you have a go – our pre-departure information booklet contains some phrases to get started!

Visas and passports

Visas are not needed by UK or EC passport holders. You should check with your nearest Portuguese consulate if you have a passport other than these. Check your passport is valid until after your planned return date and it is recommended that you take a copy of your travel insurance policy for consultation in case of emergency.

Time difference

The Azores are 1 hour behind UK time throughout the year.

Health

There are no special health formalities for visitors to the Azores and local hospitals are well equipped, should you be taken ill. Special fitness requirements for tours (if any) are detailed in tour 'dossiers'.

Money

Travellers cheques are expensive to cash but ATM machines are common in most towns – remember to take your PIN number for your ATM card though! Credit cards are only accepted in larger restaurants and shops so you will still need currency (Euros) for smaller establishments.

Flight prices

Our return flight prices to the Azores from the UK start at £270 per adult in the winter and at £290 in the summer including all UK and Azorean airport taxes. However, prices can vary considerably depending on the class available and the combination of islands visited. This is especially the case in July, August and September. International flights are all scheduled and are with either TAP Air Portugal or SATA International. Inter island flights are approximately £55 per flight and are booked with SATA Air Azores. There are reductions for children under 12 years of age on the date of departure.

Other UK departure airports

We can also arrange flights to the Azores (via Lisbon or Oporto) from Liverpool, Bristol and Stansted with the budget airlines and UK connecting flights from certain regional airports to Heathrow and Gatwick. These flights tend to be very restrictive and have to be paid for when booking. Once booked they usually incur 100% cancellation charges and the airlines charge amendment fees.

Via Lisbon

Flight connections from the UK are excellent. For example, in the summer you can depart Heathrow at o830 in the morning and be on São Miguel by 1430 and Faial by 1450. There are daily scheduled flights via Lisbon from Heathrow to the islands of São Miguel, Faial and Terceira. Flying time is around 2.5 hours for each leg.

Direct flight

Alternatively, you can catch the weekly flight on a Saturday from Manchester and Gatwick to the main island of São Miguel. Outbound from the UK, the flight starts in Manchester, stops to pick up in Gatwick for 50 minutes and then continues to Ponta Delgada. Returning from Ponta Delgada, the flight goes direct to Manchester and then on to Gatwick. The direct flight time is 3hrs 30mins and 5hrs 10mins with a stop.

Please note the direct flight only has 168 seats (per flight) which tend to fill up very quickly. These flights operate on Saturdays from o2nd April to 29th October 2011. It is possible to combine the direct flight with one leg via Lisbon.

Getting around the islands

Air All nine islands are linked by the local airline (SATA Air Azores) whose planes operate scheduled flights around the archipelago. They operate like buses flying to one island, stopping for 20 minutes then flying on to another island, making island hopping easy. Planes used are usually 40 and 80 seat twin propeller Bombardiers.

Ferries are fairly limited but it is possible to sail between Flores and Corvo, between São Miguel and Santa Maria and there is a good service around the central group of islands, particularly between Faial, Pico and São Jorge.

Car hire is available on most islands and we can reserve this for you. Vehicles are generally fairly new and range from super mini to people carrier. Petrol is a little lower in price than the UK. The Portuguese drive on the right and the Azorean roads although sometimes bumpy, are generally traffic free and fairly well sign posted on main routes. Mopeds and bicycles are also available for hire and a European style license (with photo ID) is required for all motorised vehicle hire (or an old style license and passport).

Taxis are an excellent way of getting around as many drivers speak English and prices are very low compared to the UK. The vehicles are generally quite new and of a high standard.

Bus services run on all of the islands and they are a very inexpensive (though slow!) way to get around the islands. The best service is offered on São Miguel where the main towns are linked 3 or 4 times a day. However, the service is definitely designed for the locals rather than visitors, so if you want to see all the sights, you might be better off hiring a car.

Car Hire



We can offer competitive car hire rates for all the islands which usually include the following:

Unlimited mileage, delivery and collection to/from any part of the islands. Local taxes, additional driver, child seats (if required) and CDW insurance.

PLEASE NOTE All cars have a collision damage excess of between €400 and €1400, however this can be removed by paying an additional premium of between €10 and €15 per day (wilful damage and driving under the influence of alcohol will void your insurance). Not included: fuel, traffic fines, Personal Accident Insurance (PAI – available when renting) and any refundable deposits. Minimum rental period is one day and the minimum age is 23 (on some islands this can be reduced to 18 with an additional payment).

Super CDW waiver: some travel insurance companies now offer policies which can be substantially more competitive than those offered by the car hire companies. If you have any questions about this please ask your travel insurance company or call us.
